Guidelines

- (a) Total involvement on arrival, provided extinguishment and damping down takes less than 1hr 30min - less 30%.
(b) Total involvement on arrival, provided extinguishment and damping down takes more than 1hr 30min - less 20%.
(c) Manner or origin - malicious or accidental ignition by an outsider or an Act of God - less 30%
(d) Where a major appliance responds in place of an auxiliary appliance because the latter is not available, the charge
(e) Where appliances respond as water back-up vehicles because of no or poor water resources, no charge is applicable
(f) *Delay in attendance, i.e. not complying with SANS 10090 attendance times for that particular risk = less 30%, viz,
